- Be prepared to open up all closets, cabinets and drawers (especially in the kitchen)
- Be prepared to turn on all lights
- Have a measuring tape handy for any items that will require custom packing in bespoke crates.
- Have a flashlight handy for any poorly lit spaces

Video surveys generally take far less time to complete than traditional In-Home Consultations. On average, the length of time required to complete the virtual survey is related to the size of your residence:

Studio or 1 Bedroom: 5 - 10 minutes

2 Bedroom: 10 - 15 minutes
3 Bedroom: 20 - 25 minutes
4(+) Bedroom: 30 - 40+ minutes
